MEMBERSHIP FEES

Entrance Fee

The Entrance fee for both Ordinary Members and Associate Members is Rs. 2000/- currently. This is an one-time payment which has to be made along with the Application Form through a Demand Draft payable to the Indian Paint Association at Kolkata.

Annual Membership Fee

The Annual Subscription for each Ordinary Member and Associate Member is Rs. 2000/- at present.

Additional Subscription

The Ordinary Members have to pay in addition to the Annual Membership Fee an Additional Subscription depending on their Turnover. For Ordinary Members having turnover upto Rs. 1 crore, there is no Additional Subscription. The current rates of Additional Subscription as applicable to Ordinary Members are given below.

THE INDIAN PAINT ASSOCIATION

A PROFILE

The Indian Paint Association (IPA) is a national body which represents both the Organized Sector and the Small Scale Sector. It is a voluntary non-political and non-profit organization which promotes the interests of the paint industry and the society.

IPA was founded by amalgamating the former two associations, Indian Paint Manufacturers Association and Paint Federation, on 1st July, 1960. The first important assignment undertaken by the IPA was to organize an All India Conference of Paint Manufacturers to discuss the various problems that arose. With this, the IPA took upon itself the onus of steering the course of the paint industry.

In its formative years the IPA devoted considerable time and effort to examine the problems of fiscal issues, DGS & D and so on, so as to redress the difficulties arising out of Government's regulatory and control measures. With the new perspective of a liberalized economy, the IPA is now changing its focus to a more promotive role from the erstwhile protective role.

The IPA seeks to effectively channel and reinforce the endeavours of the paint industry to contribute towards development and to help improve the standards by making the products of high technology easily available.

To achieve this, the Association has been striving:

- (a) To promote, maintain and advance interests of manufacturers of paints and other allied products.
- (b) To provide a forum for exchange of ideas, views, information and recommendation on any problems faced by manufacturers of paints and allied products in India for around development.
- (c) To encourage work studies, research activities with the aim of improving the manufacture of paints.
- (d) To advance technical know-how used in the manufacture of paints and to disseminate knowledge and information to the members
- (e) Generally to do all other things and activities which go towards achieving these objectives.
